

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CITY OF ANDERSON
2022 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD & PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE is given that a draft of the Program Year (PY) 2022 Annual Action Plan (AAP) for the City of Anderson will be available for a thirty (30) day public comment period to review and make comments. Notice is also given that a Public Hearing will be held to review and discuss the draft AAP. PY 2022 begins July 1, 2022 and ends June 30, 2023.

The PY 2022 AAP outlines proposed projects and activities by the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to address the identified priority needs and goals of the Consolidated Plan. The City expects to receive an estimated \$594,314 in CDBG funding from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) for the 2022 program year. In addition to these funds, the City also anticipates \$29,678 in Program Income and \$200,000 in Revolving Loan Funds for housing rehab activities. The City has budgeted for PY 2022:

Administration : \$118,863
Public Facilities & Infrastructure: \$475,451
Housing Rehab: \$229,678

Public Comment Period: A 30-day comment period is scheduled to begin on **June 1, 2022 and end on June 30, 2022**. The proposed plan will be available at the Community Development Department office at 601 S.
